#### Binghamton Advantage Program

- Innovative program between Binghamton University & SUNY Broome Community College
- Admitted to SUNY Broome/provisionally admitted to Binghamton

- C Students enter with their graduating class, move in with all new freshmen, integrated into the campus community from the start
- OR Use services and participate in activities on both campuses

Program Requirements for Seamless Transfer

- C Students must complete 30 credits year 1; 18 credits fulfilling General Education requirements
- All credits transfer (coordinated advisement of students)
- Academic advisement in May

## **Enrollment & Retention**

௸Fall 2010: First cohort limited to 40 students
௸Fall 2017: cohort of 250 students

Must complete a full academic year at SUNY Broome

Retention rate: 90%

Complete in 4 years

### **Administrative Challenges**

Approximately 18 months of planning prior to implementation

- C Logistical problems dealing with two campuses
- Administration of program time intensive
- Tracking BAP students can be difficult
- Coordination between campus offices

- Admitted to MV/Provisionally admitted to Utica

- OR Use services and participate in activities on both campuses (not athletics at Utica)
- Started in Fall 2016 with 300 invitees and 15 enrolled○ Fall 2017 228 offers
