- needs: full time vs. part time, evenings vs. days, on-line vs. on ground

TRANSFER CREDIT AUDIT FROM RECEIVING INSTITUTION

MAY VARY BASED ON CHOICE OF DEGREE/MAJOR FROM THE 4-YEAR COLLEGE

DO I HAVE TO TAKE A STANDARDIZED TEST?

• VARIES BY COLLEGE AND MAJOR

QCC

 RECOMMENDATION: STAY FOR AT LEAST 24 TRANSFERABLE CREDITS IN ORDER FOR TEST SCORES TO BE WAIVED AT MOST 4-YEAR COLLEGES

SIMMONS

• MOST MAJORS: TEST SCORES WAIVED WITH 32+ COMPLETED COLLEGE CREDITS OR IF STUDENT IS 24 OR OLDER

• NURSING/PHYSICAL THERAPY: TEST SCORES REQUIRED EXCEPT FOR SECOND BACHELOR'S CANDIDATES
