

SUNY's New Transfer Tools

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- Recent GAO Report to Congress:
- 35% of students transferred at least once
- 62% transferred between public schools
- Lost 43% of their credits (37% public to public)
- Financial impact on students, government
 - Half of transfers received Pell grants
 - Two-thirds receive Federal Direct Loans
- “more complete information... can help students avoid making uninformed transfer decisions that could add to the time and expense of earning a degree”
- SUNY: Seamless Transfer Initiatives, Policies
 - New Tools: Transfer Finder provides supporting tools, more information earlier in process

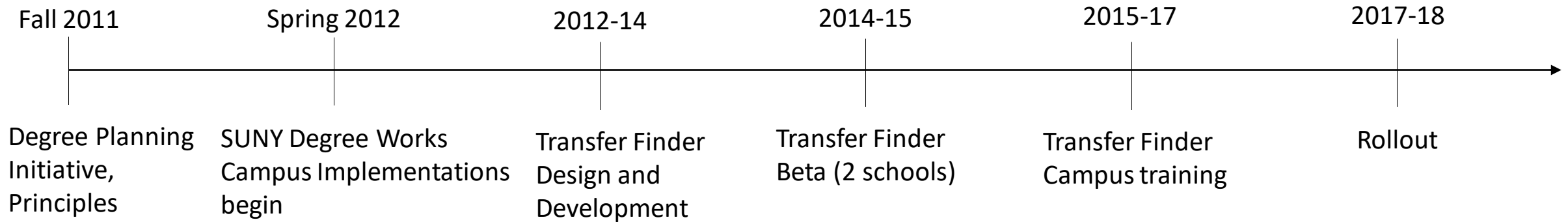

- **Brief Project History**



- **System-wide implementation of Degree Works degree audit system**
 - Every SUNY student must have access to effective degree planning services
 - Must be able to assess degree progress online
- **Transfer Finder**
 - Conduct a “what-if” degree analysis across campuses through a common, SUNY-wide online system
 - General Education, mobility programs

Concepts / Nomenclature

- Networked
 - Configured to allow student data retrieval
- “Outbound”
 - Students, Advisors can do a “what-if” against other schools
- “Inbound”
 - Students, Advisors at other schools can do a “what-if” against your campus programs

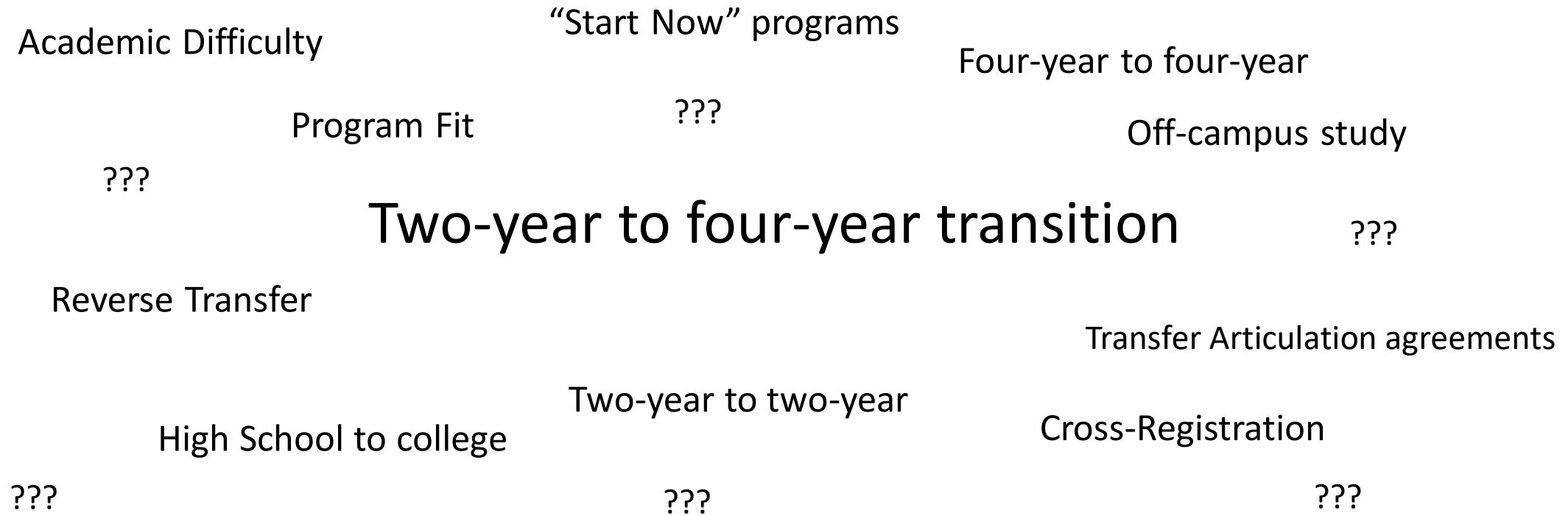

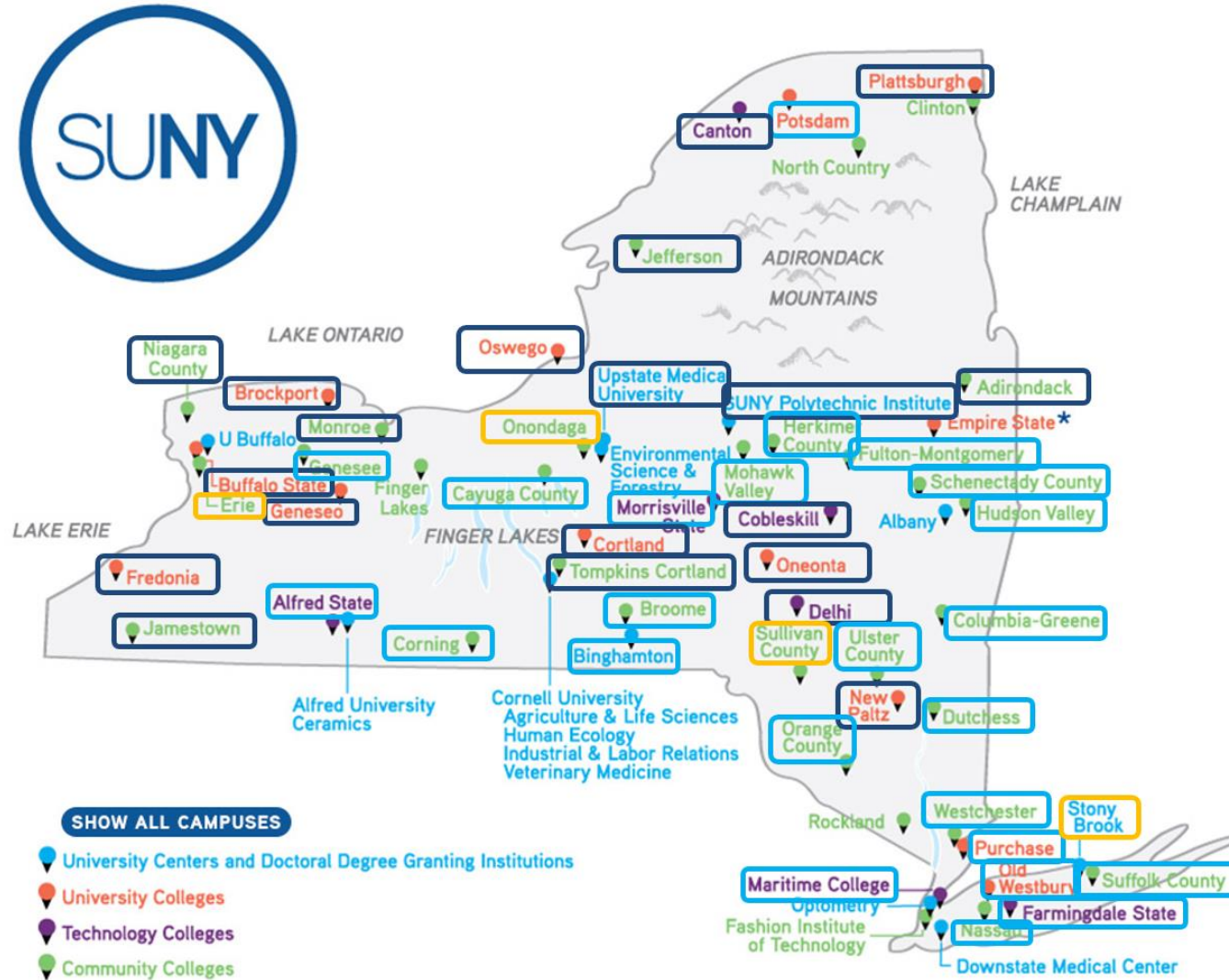
Objectives / Outcomes

- 45 Campuses networked for exchange of coursework and access to transfer equivalent courses
 - Current: 43
- 45 Campuses done with “outbound” testing
 - Current: 30
- 35 schools available for “inbound” what-if audits
 - Current: 20
- Provide access to advisors, students
