DEFINITIONS: CREDIT FOR PRIOR LEARNING



AMERICAN COUNCIL ON
EDUCATION (ACE)

- Academic credit for demonstrated college-level equivalencies gained through learning experiences outside of the college classroom, using one of the well-established methods for assessing extra-institutional learning, including third-party validation of formal training or individualized assessment, such as portfolios.



COUNCIL FOR ADULT AND
EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING (CAEL)

- A term for various methods that colleges, universities, and other education/training providers use to evaluate and formally recognize learning that has occurred outside of the traditional academic environment. It is used to grant college credit, certification, or advanced standing toward further education or training.

METHODS FOR EARNING CREDIT FOR PRIOR LEARNING

1. Standardized Exams

- AP, IB, CLEP
- DANTES Subject Standardized Test (DSST)
- Excelsior College Exams

2. Third-party Evaluations

- American Council on Education (ACE)
- National College Credit Recommendation Service (NCRRS)

3. Individualized Assessment

- Portfolios, demonstrations, or oral interviews to assess learning from work or volunteer service

4. Institution-led Assessment

- Challenge-exam

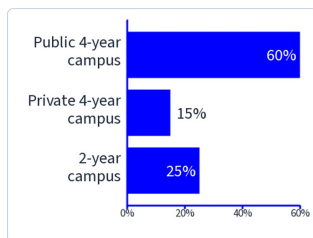

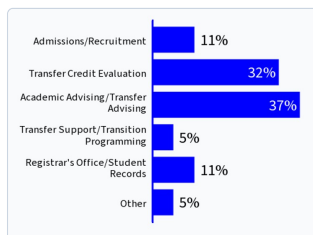

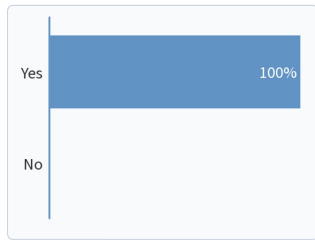

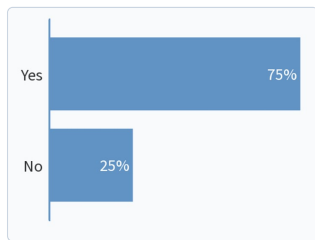

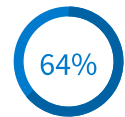

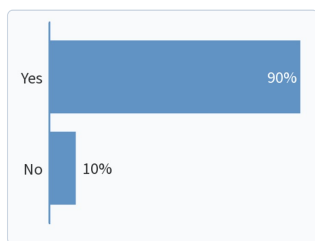

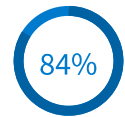
