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


- Participants will learn about ASAP and ACE program
- Participants will learn how to foster cross campus collaborations
- Participants will learn how to recruit in a remote environment





What is ASAP?



- Qualify for NYC resident tuition
- Pursue study in an ASAP eligible major
- Applicants cannot have more than 1 remedial course
- Full time every semester (minimum 12 credits)
- Benefits: Advisement, Financial Support, MetroCard and Textbook Voucher.







- Expansion of the ASAP model to senior colleges supporting baccalaureate completion
- Transfer applicants must have earned CUNY associate degree
- Students must take 15 credits each semester
- Students must be enrolled in ACE-eligible major, including having completed prerequisites in certain programs







- Interest form
- Transfer Credit Evaluation (TCE)
- Review of eligibility requirements
- Orientation





Choice of Major

- Students are provided with the list of eligible majors at both campuses
- Eligible majors have been reviewed and approved
- Approved Majors
 - Our journey with the addition of majors
 - BCC ASAP accepts all majors with the exception of 2
- Major selections are directly tied to career goals

Challenges & Solutions

- Fall Admission Only
- Prerequisites for eligible majors
 - Alternatives for majors
- Understanding course equivalencies in T-Rex
- Availability of classes
- Transition to senior college
 - 15 credit requirement
 - Academic rigor
 - Larger support network
- Commit Early
 - Info sessions





ASAP Transfer Liaisons

- Bridge between the Transfer Services Office and the BCC ASAP program
- Disseminate information with our advising colleagues and across our team to increase awareness.
 - Advisors now automatically mention ACE when discussing transfer options
- When colleagues have questions they streamline through us and we can reach out to ACE directly to get answers

Pre-Pandemic vs. Pandemic

PRE-PANDEMIC

- Campus tours, meet with advisement staff at Lehman
- Mike came to BCC to meet with students, discuss ACE and get contact info of interested students
- Invited transfer advisors to info sessions and students could meet with them after info session to get transfer application assistance



Pre-Pandemic vs. Pandemic PANDEMIC

- No on campus tours, no in-person anything
- Conducted info sessions over zoom during Fall and Spring semesters according to application deadlines
 - Flyers for event had zoom link embedded, easier access to meeting
- Interest forms submitted through Google Forms, quicker filtration for eligible students
- Continued to invite transfer services to info sessions, provide students with their contact info
- Larger turnout of students during virtual info sessions, more accessible

ASAP Data Trends

- Fall 2021 63 BCC students enrolled in ACE out of 136 transfer students
- Two info sessions held in February 2022 with 71 students attending
 - 39 students filled out interest forms
- Percentage of transfer students from BCC ASAP;
 Percentage of transfer students from any ASAP program
 - 2019: 46%, 75%
 - 2020: 46%, 86%
 - 2021: 46%, 83%
