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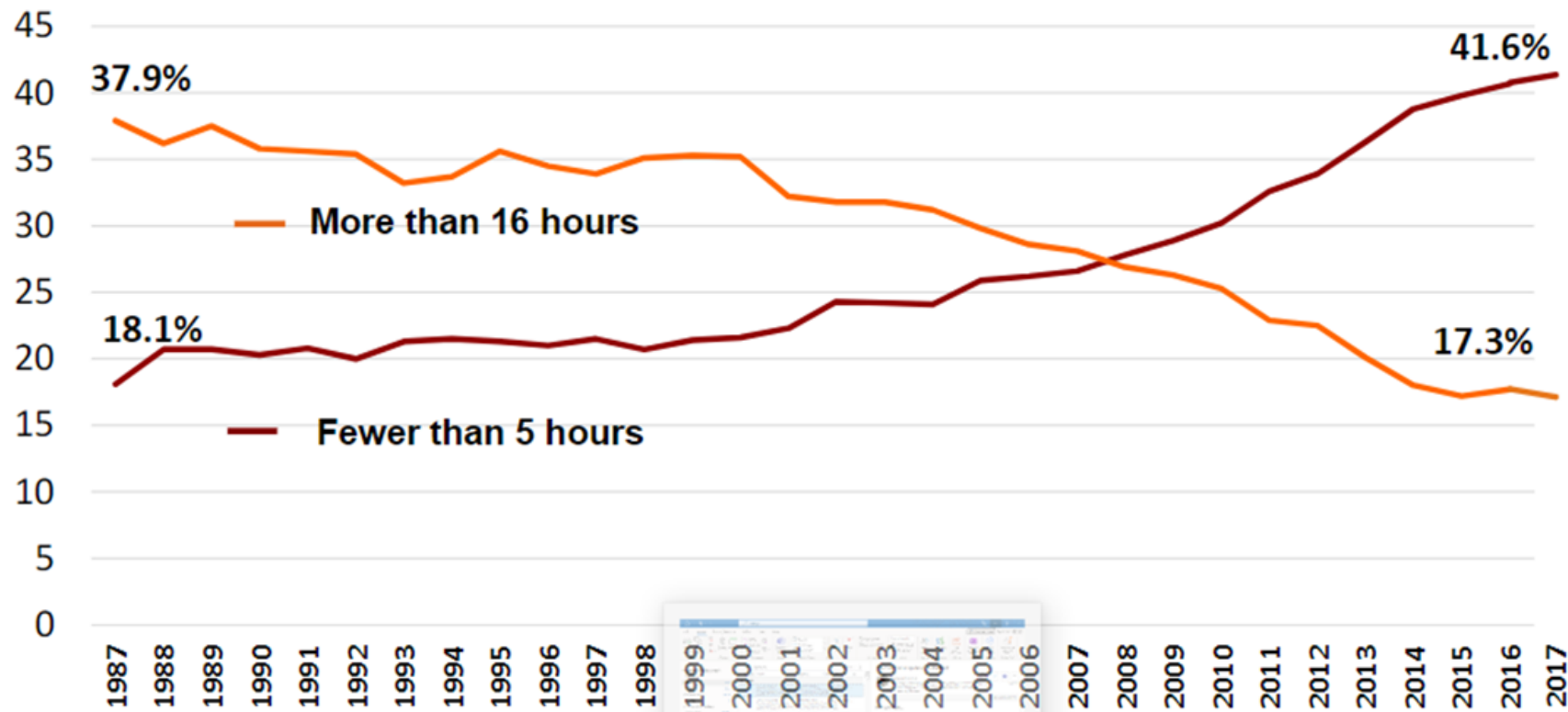

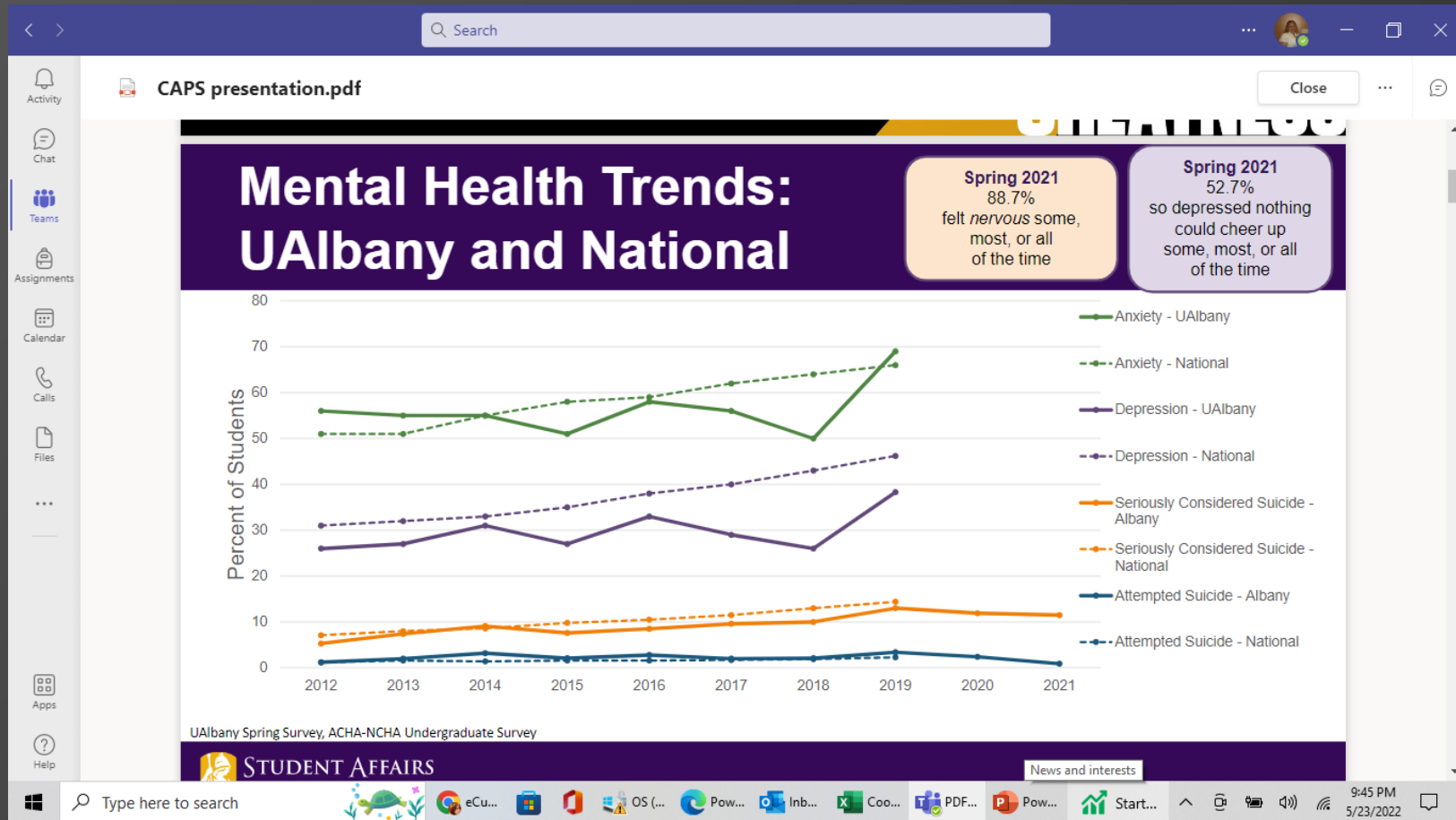

- Assessment guides practice
 - Partner with Institutional Research and Student Affairs on survey, data analysis, and retention studies
- Unique FYE programs for transfers that have faculty and staff commitment
 - Transfer communities lead by faculty and advisors in academic departments
 - Partner with departments to offer transfer only sections of “Challenges” classes
 - Advocacy for transfer programming and concerns in academic departments - especially important because that’s where curriculum innovation occurs.
 - 0 credit engagement classes

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FYE Pathways & Transfer Support

- **Transfer Transition Leaders (TTLs)**
 - Each student has a TTL who they can communicate with in the summer and during the semester. Student leaders hold programs all over the main campus and in the Transfer/Commuter Lounge!
